IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 1. <u>Registration of Candidates</u>. It is mandatory for the candidates to register through the official e-counselling online portal to be able to obtain seats to be allocated through AISSAC in any of the existing and New Sainik Schools. Candidates to note, no registration of candidates would be allowed post closure of registration window for online counselling or Spot Admission Round (Offline).
- 2. <u>Counselling for Candidates</u>. Counselling on AISSAC-2025 portal {online counselling and Spot Admission (offline counselling)} would be undertaken only for **AISSEE-2025 qualified candidates**.
- 3. <u>Counselling Fees for Candidates</u>. There is **no participation fees for counselling** on AISSAC portal. Registration and Filling-in of choices on the online AISSAC portal is free of cost.
- 4. <u>Choice Filling and Prioritisation of Schools</u>. You will not be allowed to edit your choice list after the deadline for choice filling, i.e., you cannot change the order of your choices NOR add any more schools NOR delete any school from the choice list after the deadline for choice filling. However, the qualified candidates would be able to prioritise their choice of schools prior to start of online counselling in given window; and also once again prior to commencement of Spot Admission Round (Offline).
- 5. <u>Authorised Agents for counselling</u>. There are no authorised e-counselling cells/agents available. The candidates and his/her parents/legal guardians will have to read the SOP, understand, and fill the details in the e-Counselling portal themselves. Sainik Schools Society or the Sainik Schools/ New Sainik Schools will not be responsible for any such unauthorised actions in this regard.
- 6. <u>Seat Matrix for Schools</u>. The category-wise intake capacity known as seat matrix will be announced on the online portal, <u>https://pesa.ncog.gov.in/sainikschoolecounselling</u>.

GENERAL

- 1. Sainik Schools Society (SSS), an autonomous organisation under the Ministry of Defence, Govt of India is a registered society under the Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860 and manages Sainik Schools including approved New Sainik Schools located in various parts of the country. These schools are involved in imparting quality education and training to Cadets to be good citizens and prepare them to join the Defence Forces as well as excel in all walks of life. Admissions in the Sainik Schools and the Approved New Sainik Schools in partnership mode are governed by the Sainik Schools Society (SSS). At present, there are a total of 33 existing Sainik Schools and 41 approved New Sainik Schools across the country.
- 2. <u>Sainik Schools (SS)</u>. Sainik Schools are wholly residential English medium schools that offer a common curriculum and are affiliated with the CBSE, New Delhi. Sainik Schools prepare Cadets to join the National Defence Academy (NDA), Khadakwasla (Pune), Indian Naval Academy, Ezhimala and other Training Academies as officers in addition to the All India Senior School Certificate Examination. All existing Sainik Schools cater for the Science stream subjects only. Besides academic advancement, the students are encouraged to develop their creative faculties through co-curricular activities and socially useful productive works. They are also introduced systematically to all major games and are imparted with NCC training. A list of existing Sainik Schools are given at **Appendix-A**.
- 3. New Sainik Schools (NSS). The Ministry of Defence (MoD) had approved the scheme for setting up of approved New Sainik Schools, in partnership mode with NGOs/private schools/State Governments. These approved New Sainik Schools, besides their affiliation to respective Education Boards, function under the aegis of the Sainik Schools Society and follow the Rules and Regulations for approved New Sainik Schools prescribed by the Sainik Schools Society. In addition to their regular affiliated Board curriculum, they also impart education of Academic-PLUS curriculum to the students on the Sainik School pattern. The fee structure, Education Board and language of Instructions of approved New Sainik Schools differ from School to School. A list of approved New Sainik Schools are given at Appendix-B.

<u>ADMISSIONS</u>

- 4. <u>All India Sainik School Entrance Examination (AISSEE)</u>. Admission is based on the performance of candidates in the All-India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination (AISSEE). The admission of candidates will be carried out on the basis of e-counselling as per rank secured by the candidates in the school wise, gender wise, category wise (Home State and Outside State) Merit List of AISSEE-2025, medical fitness approved by competent medical authorities, verification of original documents and payment of school fees.
- 5. Admission to Sainik School is in Class VI and Class IX only through AISSEE-2025 for the academic year 2025-26. Admission for Sainik School pattern in the approved New Sainik Schools is in Class VI and Class IX (17 NSS) through AISSEE-2025 for the academic year 2025-26.
- 6. Sainik Schools Society has developed an e-counselling portal for admission into existing and New Sainik Schools named **All India Sainik School Admission Counselling (AISSAC)**. It is mandatory for the candidates to register through the official e-counselling online portal to be able to obtain seats to be allocated through AISSAC in any of the existing and New Sainik Schools. The category-wise intake capacity known as seat matrix will be announced on the online portal, https://pesa.ncog.gov.in/sainikschoolecounselling.

- 7. The SOP stated herein will be followed for allocating seats for the above-referenced admissions for the academic year 2025-26, through All India Sainik Schools Admission Counselling-2025.
- 8. The seat allocation process follows a strict timeline and procedure. The entire process is online, and computer operated. No exceptions are possible and therefore, candidates are strongly advised to thoroughly acquaint themselves with SOP, be vigilant, keep their documents handy and make arrangements for making the requisite payments, well in advance. It will not be possible to entertain requests for an extension of time for adhering to a timeline or for completing any activity. Candidates having any queries may reach out to the Sainik Schools/SSS. The contact numbers and email ids are mentioned on the portal in the Sainik School information tab.
- 9. A seat to the highest possible choice of school is allocated to the candidate in e- counselling considering the following factors: -
 - (a) Domicile of the candidate's Home State (HS) or Other State (OS) as described in AISSEE-2025 information bulletin.
 - (b) The category [GEN, OBC-NCL, SC, ST, DEF] of the candidate.
 - (c) All India Rank of the candidate in the respective rank list(s).
 - (d) The order of preference of schools selected by the candidate.
 - (e) The availability of seats in different seat categories/seat quotas for which the candidate is eligible.
 - (f) Other rules as mentioned in this SOP.
- 10. National Testing Agency (NTA) conducts AISSEE and Sainik Schools Society frames the policies and norms for seat allocation to Sainik Schools. Bhaskaracharya National Institute for Space Applications and Geo-informatics (BISAG-N) extends its technical support for providing the services of e-Counselling and Admission for the above-said activities carried out by SSS.
- 11. No agency other than AISSAC/ SSS is responsible for seat allocation to the seats at existing and approved New Sainik Schools. Candidates seeking information/assistance from any agency/ agent other than authorised by AISSAC/ SSS shall be doing so at their own risk and cost. There is only one AISSAC-2025 official website, viz., https://pesa.ncog.gov.in/sainikschoolecounselling.
- 12. Any student who has appeared for AISSEE-2025 and has secured qualifying marks is eligible to apply for e-counselling through the AISSAC portal (Qualification criteria are explained in the AISSEE Information bulletin 2025).

RESERVATION CRITERIA

- 13. Reservation# criteria for existing 33 Sainik Schools.
 - (a) 67% of the seats are reserved for candidates domiciled in the State/ UT where the Sainik School is located. 33% of the seats are reserved for candidates from Other States and Union Territories (UT). Within each Category of Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT quota, seats will be reserved on the following lines: -
 - (i) 15% of the seats are reserved for the category Scheduled Caste (SC),
 - (ii) 7.5% for the category Scheduled Tribe (ST) and
 - (iii) 27% for the category Other Backward Classes belonging to the Non- Creamy layer (OBC-NCL) as per the central list.
 - (b) Thus, 49.5% of the seats in Sainik School are reserved on the above-mentioned lines in both Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT quota. Out of the balance 50.5% of the seats in both Home State/ UT and Other States/ UT quota, 25% of the seats are reserved for wards of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy / Indian Air Force) personnel and ex- servicemen.
 - (c) In "Other States/ UT" quota, seats will be allotted in each category as per merit, subject to a maximum limit of 25% of vacancies in all the categories (i.e. SC, ST, OBC-NCL, DEF & GEN) for each State or Union Territory. E.g. If there are 10 seats in Other States/UT Category, Candidates of any particular State/UT will not be granted more than 3 seats (25% of 10 or 2.5 rounded off to 3).
 - (d) In Class VI of each Sainik School, 10% of the total vacancies or 10 seats, (whichever is more), are reserved for girl candidates.

The reservation of seats in Sainik Schools is subject to the outcome of Writ Petition (Madurai Bench) No. 26623 of 2024 and Writ Miscellaneous Petition (Madurai Bench) No. 22585 of 2024 at the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.

14. Reservation in approved New Sainik Schools. There is no policy for the implementation of reservation in New Sainik Schools from SSS. The reservation in New Sainik Schools is as per decision of the School management or competent authority.

CATEGORISATION OF CANDIDATES

- 15. <u>For Sainik Schools</u>. The concept of Home State (HS) and Outside State (OS) is linked to the domicile of the candidate and is determined with reference to the location of the Sainik School opted by him/her in his application during registration for AISSEE-2025 on NTA portal.
- 16. For the purpose of seat allocation, AISSEE-2025 qualified candidates are categorised based on their domicile. On the basis of such a categorisation, each candidate is assigned a category tag as given below: -

- (a) For Home State (HS). A candidate is deemed to belong to the Home State (HS), if his State/UT of domicile and the State/UT where the Sainik School opted by him in his application is located, are the same. For example, a candidate who is domiciled in the State of Gujarat has opted for Sainik School at Balachadi (Gujarat) in his AISSEE-2025 application and opts Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra) at the time e-counselling as his second option, then the candidate is deemed to belong to the Home State (HS) of Gujarat for the purpose of admission to Sainik School Balachadi (Gujarat) and is deemed to belong to the Outside State (OS) for the purpose of admission to the Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra), in case, the candidate does not get seat allocation in Sainik School Balachadi.
 - (i) <u>Category tag GEN (HS)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (HOME_GEN) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid domicile certificate to be assigned this tag.
 - (ii) <u>Category tag OBC-NCL (HS)</u>. This is assigned to the candidate of Other Backward Classes (HOME_OBC) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.
 - (iii) <u>Category tag SC (HS)</u>. This is assigned to the candidate of Scheduled Castes (HOME_SC) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.
 - (iv) <u>Category tag ST (HS)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (HOME_ST) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.
 - (v) <u>Category tag DEF (HS)</u>. This is assigned to the candidate who is a ward of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (HOME_DEF) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce valid documents/certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.
- (b) For Outside State (OS). A candidate is deemed to belong to Other State (OS), if his State/UT of domicile and the State/UT where the Sainik School opted by him in his application/e-counselling is located, are different. For example, a candidate who is domiciled in the State of Gujarat has opted for the Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra) in his AISSEE-2025 application as his first option, and opted for Sainik School Balachadi (Gujarat) at the time of e-counselling as his second option, then the candidate is deemed to belong to the Outside State (OS) for the purpose of admission to Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra) and is deemed to belong to the Home State (HS) for the purpose of admission to the Sainik School Balachadi (Gujarat), in case, the candidate does not get seat allocation in Sainik School Satara (Maharashtra).
 - (i) <u>Category tag GEN (OS)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (OTHER GEN) and considered for Outside State.

- (ii) <u>Category tag OBC-NCL (OS)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Other Backward Classes (OTHER_OBC) and considered for Outside State. Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate to be assigned this tag. The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.
- (iii) <u>Category tag SC (OS)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Castes (OTHER_SC) and considered for Outside State. Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.
- (iv) <u>Category tag ST (OS)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (OTHER_ST) and considered for Outside State. Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.
- (v) <u>Category tag DEF (OS)</u>. This is assigned to the candidate who are wards of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (OTHER_DEF) and considered for Outside State. Candidates must produce valid documents/ certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.

Note-

- From Academic Year 2025-26, the candidates of Telangana State domicile would not be considered under the 67% seats reserved for 'Home State' category for admission to Sainik School Kalikiri (Andhra Pradesh) and Sainik School Korukonda (Andhra Pradesh). Such candidates of Telangana State domicile would be eligible for admission in these schools mentioned, under the 33% seats reserved for 'Other State' candidates.
- 2. Ladakh (UT) candidates will be considered in Home State for admission in Sainik School Nagrota located in Jammu and Kashmir.

17. For New Sainik Schools - 40% route (NSS40).

- (a) At least 40% of the seats under the Sainik School stream in approved NSSs will be filled on the basis of the rank secured in the All India (AI) Merit List of AISSEE-2025.
- (b) New Sainik Schools does not follow any uniform reservation policy with regard to allocation of seats. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category-wise, then each candidate is assigned a category tag as given below:-
 - (i) <u>Category tag GEN (NSS40)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (NSS40_GEN). For the purpose of admissions under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in General Category.
 - (ii) <u>Category tag OBC-NCL (NSS40)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Other Backward Classes (NSS40_OBC). Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate to be assigned this tag. The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.

- (iii) <u>Category tag SC (NSS40)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Castes (NSS40_SC). Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.
- (iv) <u>Category tag ST (NSS40)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (NSS40_ST). Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.
- (v) <u>Category tag DEF (NSS40)</u>. This is assigned to the candidate who is a ward of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (NSS40_DEF) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce valid documents/certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.

18. For New Sainik Schools - 60% route (NSS60).

- (a) Up to 60% of the seats in NSSs will be filled by the candidates currently studying in Class V/VIII in any of the approved NSSs who have appeared and qualified for AISSEE-2025. They will be filled on the basis of rank secured by the candidate in the school and availability of seats filled by their respective school.
- (b) Candidates in this category are assigned a tag of **NSS60**. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category-wise, then each candidate is assigned a category tag as given below: -
 - (i) <u>Category tag GEN (NSS60)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of the general category (NSS60_GEN). For the purpose of admissions under the NSS60 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in General Category.
 - (ii) <u>Category tag OBC-NCL (NSS60)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Other Backward Classes (NSS60_OBC). Candidates must produce a valid OBC-NCL certificate to be assigned this tag. The backward class MUST be in the Central List of OBCs published by the National Commission for Backward Classes.
 - (iii) <u>Category tag SC (NSS60)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Castes (NSS60_SC). Candidates must produce a valid SC certificate to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Caste MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India.
 - (iv) <u>Category tag ST (NSS60)</u>. This is assigned to a candidate of Scheduled Tribes (NSS60_ST) Candidates must produce a valid ST certificate along with domicile to be assigned this tag. The Scheduled Tribe MUST be listed in the respective State-wise List published by the Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Government of India.

(v) <u>Category tag DEF (NSS60)</u>. This is assigned to the candidate who is a ward of Defence (Serving personnel of Indian Army/ Indian Navy/ Indian Air Force) personnel and ex-servicemen (NSS60_DEF) and considered for Home State. Candidates must produce valid documents/certificates [e.g. Certificate of Service (for Defence category-serving), PPO for (Ex- servicemen) etc] along with domicile to be assigned this tag.

Explanation of 40% & 60% Route.

- (a) A minimum of 40% (Category 'A') of the seats will be filled by drawing candidates who appear and qualify in the AISSE Examination conducted by NTA and are desirous of taking admission to the New Sainik School through the merit list of AISSEE conducted by NTA.
- (b) A maximum of 60% (**Category 'B'**) of the total number of seats may be filled by Students already enrolled in that School, based on a qualifying test conducted by NTA or any other appropriate testing body as prescribed by SSS to be taken by students of Class V of the same school who are willing to take admission in Sainik School Vertical.
- (c) In cases where the school is unable to fill its seats with **Category 'B'** students who are already enrolled in school, the vacancies will be filled by drawing candidates from **Category 'A'** students who appear and qualify in the AISSE Examination conducted by NTA and are desirous of taking admission in the New Sainik School through the merit list of AISSEE conducted by NTA.

DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS

19. <u>Sainik Schools</u>. The total intake (i.e., the number of seats) for the purpose of admission is divided into different categories. These are HOME_DEF, HOME_OBC, HOME_SC, HOME_ST, HOME_UN, OTHER_DEF, OTHER_OBC, OTHER_SC, OTHER_ST, OTHER_UN. The category tags of candidates who are eligible in different Category sections are shown in the table below: -

20. New Sainik Schools.

(a) <u>NSS40% Route</u>. In case, if any school decides to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then the total intake (i.e., the number of seats) for the purpose of admission through the NSS40 Route is divided into different categories. These are NSS40_UN, NSS40_OBC, NSS40_DEF, NSS40_SC, NSS40_ST. For the purpose of admissions under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in General Category and will be assigned the NSS40_GEN tag (except Kranthiveera Sangolli Rayanna Sainik School). The category tags of candidates who are eligible in different Category sections are shown in the table below: -

(b) <u>NSS60% Route</u>. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then the total intake (i.e., the number of seats) for the purpose of admission through the NSS60 Route is divided into different categories. These are NSS60_UN, NSS60_OBC, NSS60_DEF, NSS60_SC, NSS60_ST. For the purpose of admissions under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates will be considered in the General Category and will be assigned the NSS60_GEN tag (except Kranthiveera Sangolli Rayanna Sainik School). The category tags of candidates who are eligible in different Category sections are shown in the table below: -

<u>Note-</u> In approved New Sainik School, if seats are filled in Gender Neutral, then seat allocation to candidates will be as per merit irrespective of Gender.

- 21. The school-wise number of seats available in SSs and NSSs for different candidate categories/quotas, if applicable (i.e., seat matrix), will be available on the online portal https://pesa.ncog.gov.in/sainikschoolecounselling.
- 22. AISSAC-2025 allocates seats as per the seat matrix data provided by the participating schools. It is the sole responsibility of each participating school to provide the seat matrix data taking into consideration the reservation and other policies applicable to them / decided by them. AISSAC-2025 / Sainik Schools Society is NOT responsible for the seat matrix data.

RANK LIST

- 23. <u>Sainik Schools</u>. Seat allocation in SSs is based on AISSEE-2025 All India Rank. The following TYPES of rank lists will be used: -
 - (a) <u>For Home State</u>. All candidates (boys and girls both) who belong to the Home State category as explained in this document in Para 16 (a) above will be considered for allocation to the Sainik School/s located in their Home State.
 - (i) <u>Home State-Unreserve rank list (HOME_UN)</u>. In the HOME_UN category, the candidates who belong to the Home State category based on their All-India Rank and Domicile irrespective of their category (SC, ST, OBC-NCL & DEF) will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME_UN, HOME_OBC, HOME_SC and HOME_ST.
 - (ii) <u>Home State-OBC (NCL) rank list (HOME OBC)</u>. In the HOME_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates who belong to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME OBC.
 - (iii) <u>Home State-SC rank list (HOME SC)</u>. In the HOME_SC category, the SC category candidates belonging to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME SC.
 - (iv) <u>Home State-ST rank list (HOME ST)</u>. In the HOME_ST category, the ST category candidates belonging to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME_ST.
 - (v) <u>Home State-Defence rank list (HOME DEF)</u>. In the HOME_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Home State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in their Home State. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag HOME DEF.
 - (b) <u>For Outside State</u>. All candidates belonging to the Outside State category as explained in this document in Para 16 (b) above will be considered for allocation to the Sainik School/s located in Other States.
 - (i) <u>Outside State-Unreserve rank list (OTHER UN)</u>. In the OTHER_UN category, the candidates belong to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile irrespective of their category (SC, ST & OBC-NCL) will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER_UN, OTHER_OBC, OTHER_SC and OTHER_ST.
 - (ii) <u>Outside State-OBC (NCL) rank list (OTHER OBC)</u>. In the OTHER_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in the Outside state (other than located in the Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER OBC.

- (iii) <u>Outside State-SC rank list (OTHER SC)</u>. In the OTHER_SC category, the SC category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER SC.
- (iv) <u>Outside State-ST rank list (OTHER ST)</u>. In the OTHER_ST category, the ST category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER_ST.
- (v) <u>Outside State-Defence rank list (OTHER DEF)</u>. In the OTHER_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Outside State category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation of the Sainik School/s in the Outside state (other than located in Home State). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag OTHER DEF.

24. New Sainik Schools- NSS 40% route.

- (a) <u>NSS40-Unreserve rank list (NSS40 UN)</u>. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then in the NSS40_UN category, the candidates on their All India Rank irrespective of their category (SC, ST & OBC-NCL) will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. For the purpose of seat allotment under the NSS40 Route, the Defence category candidates, for admission into these New Sainik Schools will be considered under the General Category (except Kranthiveera Sangolli Rayanna Sainik School). It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_UN, NSS40_OBC, NSS40_DEF, NSS40_SC, and NSS40_ST.
- (b) NSS40-OBC (NCL) rank list (NSS OBC). In the NSS40_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40 OBC.
- (c) <u>NSS40-SC rank list (NSS SC)</u>. In the NSS40_SC category, the SC category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_SC.
- (d) NSS40-ST rank list (NSS ST). In the NSS40_SC category, the ST category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_ST.
- (e) <u>NSS40-Defence rank list (NSS40 DEF)</u>. In the NSS40_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Defence category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS40_DEF.

25. New Sainik Schools -For NSS 60% Route.

(a) <u>NSS60-Unreserve rank list (NSS60 UN)</u>. In case, if any school decide to follow the reservation policy and fill the seat matrix category wise, then in the NSS60_UN category, the candidates, based on the All India Rank secured (among existing school students) and seats filled by the school, will be considered for allocation in his/her own school. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_UN, NSS60_OBC, NSS60_DEF, NSS60_SC, and NSS60_ST.

- (b) <u>NSS60-OBC (NCL) rank list (NSS60 OBC)</u>. In the NSS40_OBC category, the OBC-NCL category candidates, based on the All India Rank secured (among existing school students) and seats filled by the school, will be considered for allocation in his/her own school. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_OBC.
- (c) <u>NSS60-SC rank list (NSS60 SC)</u>. In the NSS60_SC category, the SC category candidates, based on the All India Rank secured (among existing school students) and seats filled by the school, will be considered for allocation in his/her own school. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_SC.
- (d) <u>NSS60-ST rank list (NSS60 ST)</u>. In the NSS60_ST category, the ST category candidates based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60 ST.
- (e) <u>NSS60-Defence rank list (NSS40 DEF)</u>. In the NSS60_DEF category, the only Defence category candidates belonging to the Defence category based on their All India Rank and Domicile will be considered for allocation in New Sainik Schools. It includes candidates who are assigned the tag NSS60_DEF.

SEQUENCE IN WHICH SEAT CATEGORIES ARE CONSIDERED FOR SEAT ALLOCATION.

- 26. The sequence in which seat categories are considered for seat allocation for existing and New Sainik Schools is as follows: -
 - (a) For Sainik Schools. Seat allotment sequence for Sainik Schools (SSs) system for Home State (HS) and Outside States (OS) seats only.

MULTIPLE STUDENT - SAME RANK RULE

27. In the event that there are fewer number of seats available under a particular category in a school, than the number of candidates with the same category-wise rank seeking admission to the same school, then all those candidates will be offered seats by creating a requisite number of supernumerary seats after exhausting inter-se-merit of candidates as per Para 13.8 of AISSEE-2025 Information Bulletin issued by NTA.

VERIFICATION OF DETAILS

28. A correction window was already provided during registration of candidates for AISSEE-2025 to amend any details. At the time of registration on the AISSAC-2025 website, candidates will NOT be allowed any change in their personal details including name, gender, father's / mother's / guardian's name, domicile state, date of birth or category.

REGISTRATION AND FILLING-IN OF CHOICES OF SCHOOLS

- 29. For registration and filling-in of choices of schools, candidates should log in to the https://pesa.ncog.gov.in/sainikschoolecounselling using following credentials: -
 - (a) AISSEE-2025 Application Number will be entered on the portal. Hence, AISSEE-2025 candidates are advised to keep all the documents required for AISSAC-2025 ready before the start of the registration process.
 - (b) One Time Password will be sent on both the mobile number and email ID registered during AISSEE-2025 registration on the NTA portal.
 - (c) After entering OTP, Candidates will also be required to set their password. Thereafter, candidates need to log in with their Application number as their User ID and enter the password set by them.
 - (d) Upon successful login, the candidate's details will automatically be fetched from the database of AISSEE-2025 registration.
 - (e) Candidates will be asked to reconfirm the details. Only after confirmation of details, the candidates' registration will be considered successful.
 - (f) <u>Candidates not registering on AISSAC-2025 portal, will not be considered for the allocation of seats in any of the schools.</u>
 - (g) The flow chart to understand the process of e-counselling is attached at Appendix-P.

- 30. Registration and Filling-in of choices on the online portal is free of cost, i.e., candidates are NOT required to pay any fee.
- 31. The choice filling of schools will be based on the qualification result of AISSEE-2025 promulgated by NTA.
- 32. Candidates are given a window (as per the timeline on the portal) for registration (one-time only) and filling of their school choices in the order of preference. This window will **NOT** be extended under any circumstances. Requests in this matter shall not be entertained. During this period, each candidate must fill choices carefully. The candidate must select only those schools in the choices which the candidate is willing to join and prioritise them in the order of preference.
- 33. It is important for candidates to carefully prioritise the schools during the window provided, while bearing in mind that only the choices filled in would be made available for seat allocation and **only ONE seat** from among the choices filled-in will be made available to the candidate.
- 34. Candidates are advised to visit the respective school website(s) for fee structure, scholarship and other related information applicable for Individual schools. AISSAC-2025 /SSS shall not be responsible for fee structure, scholarships etc related rules applicable for Individual schools and will not entertain any request or complaint regarding the Fee Structure.
- 35. Lock-in Choices of Schools.
 - (a) Candidates MUST "LOCK" their choices on/before the last day of choice filling.
 - (b) Once locked, the choices filled by a candidate can be edited, prior to closure of last date of choice filling. This can be done by clicking on the edit option available to unlock the choices on the portal.
 - (c) If the candidate does not lock the choices, then the default choices as shown to candidate by portal will be considered for seat allocation.
- 36. <u>Prioritisation of Choices of Schools</u>. Candidates will NOT be allowed to edit their choice list after the deadline for choice filling, i.e., candidates CANNOT change the order of their choices OR add any more school/s in OR delete any school/s from their choice list after the deadline for choice filling. Candidates will be allowed to reprioritise the choice of schools one more time before commencement of Spot Admission (Offline Round). Available school and category wise vacancy list will be displayed on the portal for the information of the candidates to make informed choice regarding availability of seats.

Candidates are strongly discouraged from sharing their login information with others.

OPTION AVAILABLE TO THE CANDIDATES AFTER SEAT ALLOTMENT

- 37. It is the candidate's responsibility to log in to the AISSAC-2025 portal and check if a seat is allocated in a given round of seat allocation. A schedule of e-counselling activities will be updated on the website after every activity. If the candidate is allocated a seat, the following option will be available to the candidates, for which the candidate needs to take action (ACCEPT/RECONSIDER/HOLD &CONTINUE) before the last date/time specified for the given round, i.e. the round in which seat is allocated.
 - (a) If no action is taken by the candidate, the seat allotted to the candidate will be cancelled and it will be considered that the candidate is not interested in the counselling process and the candidate will not be able to participate in any further round of online counselling or claim admission in any school based on AISSEE-2025 merit.

- (b) Such candidates would be considered during Spot Admission-Offline Counselling subject to availability of seats.
- 38. <u>Candidates allotted school by portal</u>. The following option will be available to the candidates after allotment of school: -
 - (a) <u>ACCEPT</u>. If a candidate accepts the allotted seat, he/she has to complete admission formalities (Medical cum Physical Verification) within the prescribed time (As per the timeline). Failing to do so, the candidate will not be able to participate in any further round of counselling or claim admission in any Sainik School based on the merit of the AISSEE-2025 exam.
 - (b) <u>RECONSIDER</u>. If a candidate is not satisfied with the seat allotted, he/she can opt for the 'RECONSIDER' option to participate in the next round of counselling for the remaining available seats for other preferred schools minus the school allotted to him. However, in doing so, the allotted seat shall be automatically cancelled and no further claim will be admissible. The candidate will not be considered for the same School again. It may further be noted that reconsideration does not entail change in priorities/choices for school. The Choice of schools filled prior to commencement of online rounds will be considered for all online rounds.
 - (c) <u>HOLD & CONTINUE</u>. If a candidate is partially satisfied with the seat allotted, and wants to take admission in allotted school, but wants to be considered in subsequent rounds of counselling, he/she can opt for the 'Hold & Continue' option.
 - (i) By choosing this option, candidate has to **mandatorily** take admission in the school allotted to him by the portal. Failure to do so, would result in cancellation of his candidature for admission in Sainik Schools/ New Sainik Schools for current year.
 - (ii) The candidate once admitted to the school, would figure in the merit in subsequent rounds of online counselling, for schools higher in priority to the school already accepted by him and taken admission into. (*Please note, this would not be applicable for candidates allotted their first priority of school by the portal.*)
 - (iii) In case, the candidate is allotted a higher priority school by the portal, then he/she can choose to accept the school on the portal. Once accepted, the entire credentials of the candidate from the old school would be transferred to the new school, i.e., medical records, documents and fees deposited.
 - (iv) This is a one-time activity for the candidate, aimed at the academic pursuits of the candidate.
 - (v) Once the new school is accepted by the candidate, he/she would no longer be eligible for seat retention in previous school.
 - (vi) Due diligence by the candidate needs to be exercised, whilst opting for this option, clearly understanding the parameters given above.

Note-

- 1. On selection of either of the Accept/ Reconsider/ Hold & Continue by the candidates, a pop-up window would appear, to re-confirm their choice of Accept/ Reconsider as 'Yes' or 'No' option.
- 2. The statement of the pop-up window selection of either of the Accept/ Reconsider , would be: -

"Yes" - This is re-confirmation by candidate on his option selected.

"No" - This would re-direct the candidate back to the previous screen of selecting the options of Accept/ Reconsider

PROVISIONAL OFFER OF SEAT AND ITS CONFIRMATION

- 40. The allocation of slots for medical and reporting for physical verification of the documents will be intimated to the candidates by the allotted school through email on registered email id and SMS on mobile. The same will also be listed on the school website mentioned at **Appendix A/B**. In case candidate has received email/SMS for admission to allotted school and there is no intimation from the allotted school, the candidate is to contact the school authorities on the telephone number and email id specified at the **Appendix A/B**.
- 41. A candidate who has been allocated and **ACCEPTED** a seat in any School as per the preference of choices filled by him/her and merit, he/she has to complete admission formalities (Medical cum Physical Verification of documents) within the prescribed time (**As per the timeline on the portal**). Failing to do so, the candidate will not be able to participate in any further round of counselling or claim admission in any Sainik School based on the merit of the AISSEE-2025. The candidate accepting the allotted school needs to follow the steps as given below: -
 - (a) <u>STEP-1: REPORTING AT MEDICAL CENTRE</u>. After seat acceptance, candidates will have to report at the Medical Examination Centre as per the Slot allotted by the admitting school. It is the parent's responsibility to get the medical done of their son/daughter. However, the school will provide help to the candidates in coordinating with Medical Authorities, in case of any problem faced by the parents. For existing Sainik Schools, the format of the medical form will be available on the AISSAC-2025 portal. For the approved new Sainik School, the candidates will get a Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered Government physician. Biometric verification of the candidate with the left-hand thumb impression is to be placed on the Medical Fitness Certificate.
 - (b) <u>STEP-2: PHYSICAL VERIFICATION BY ALLOTTED SCHOOL</u>. After the medical fitness report, candidates will have to report at the admitting school, and produce all required documents to the admitting school. The admission will be cancelled, if the candidate fails to meet the requirements as per the prevailing norms. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the candidate to keep the valid certificate or document ready. All the certificates/documents will be verified at the time of Physical reporting at the admitting school. A list of suggested documents for Sainik Schools are given at Appendix-C.
 - (c) <u>STEP-3: PAYMENT OF FEE</u>. After completing the above two steps or any other admission formalities of the admitting school, pay the fees of the school and get the admission confirmed. Biometric verification of the candidate against the Registration details received along with the merit list from BISAG-N is to conducted by the school.

After completion of all formalities, Principal of the schools is requested to update the status of the candidates by clicking on ADMIT tab.

It is the candidate's responsibility to plan their travel such that the Medical cum physical verification of documents is completed by the last day of the counselling round in which they are allocated a seat (if any) [As per the timeline on the portal]. No exceptions shall be made in this regard.

- 42. Candidates on 'HOLD'. The candidates may face the following types of situations: -
 - (a) <u>Candidates Declared Medically Unfit</u>. The decision of the Medical Board will be final except where a representation has been made to the Principal. The Principal will examine the appeal himself and decide with reference to the evidence produced before him if the case calls for merit. A case in which competent medical opinion is produced to counter the finding of the previous Medical Board, will normally merit a review. Such cases will be put on 'HOLD' by the Principal. Subsequently, the Principal may coordinate with the medical authorities and arrange a Review Medical Board for the re-examination of the candidate. If the Review Medical Board finds him fit for admission, the Principal will 'ADMIT' the candidate on the portal and admit him to the school if his rejection was only on account of lack of medical fitness after Physical Verification and payment of fees. The school may charge a fee of Rs.100/- (Rs.50/- from SC/ST candidates) for holding a Review Medical Board. However, the candidate will be required to appear before the Review Medical Board at the designated place at his own expense. In the case of an UNFIT report, the Principal will click the 'REJECT' button on the Portal.
 - (b) <u>Discrepancies in the documents</u>. In case of any discrepancies in the documents during Physical Verification, query(ies) (if required) raised by the allotted school must be responded by the candidate within the last date/time specified for the given round [as per the timeline on the portal]. Additional query(ies) may be raised by the school in case discrepancy(ies) still persist(s). In such cases, the candidate must respond to the additional query(ies) within the last date/time specified for the given round [as per the timeline on the portal]. The allocated seat will be confirmed or cancelled based on the validity of the document(s) produced in response to the query(ies) and the candidate meeting the eligibility criteria. Failure to reply to the query(ies) raised would lead to seat cancellation and will be considered as a rejection of the offer. Such cases can also be put on 'HOLD' by the Principal at their discretion owing to the veracity of the case. In all HOLD cases, the seat of the school will be blocked and will not be released till the time school ADMIT /REJECT the candidate's status on the Portal.
- 43. It is the parent's/candidate's responsibility to plan their travel such that the Review Medicals cum physical verification of the documents is completed by the last day of the ecounselling round in which they are allocated a seat (if any) [as per Timeline]. No exceptions shall be made in this regard.
- 44. The Parents are also advised to keep adequate funds ready at the time of registration and choice filling for payment of the Fees, in case of allotment of school to avoid last-minute hassles. Non-payment of the fee within the Timelines subject to the fitness of Medical standards (including Review Medicals) cum physical verification, is one of the ways to reject the offered/allocated seat in school and will be treated as a rejection. In such a situation, the school may reject the candidate with reasons and the candidate will no longer be able to participate in the seat allocation process in the subsequent rounds.

45. Candidates who do not take any action to the allocated seat CANNOT participate for the same allotted seat/school further any more in Seat Allocation for the ensuing academic year 2025-26.

CATEGORY/GENDER/DOMICILE DISCREPANCIES IN THE DOCUMENT

- 46. **Gender discrepancies**. If a female candidate wrongly declares their gender as male and is allotted a seat in a school where female candidates are restricted, the allotted seat will be cancelled. Similarly, if a male candidate wrongly declares the gender as female and is allotted a Female-Only seat, the allotted seat will be cancelled. Such candidates would not be considered for any further seat allocation in AISSAC-2025.
- 47. <u>Domicile discrepancies</u>. The following rules will be applied, if there is an error in the domicile: -
 - (a) The state code of eligibility will be corrected in the AISSAC-25 database.
 - (b) Retention/cancellation of seat will be as determined by the following table: -

- (c) Candidate will be considered for seat allocation in subsequent round(s) for the remaining seats for seat allocation (if any), provided all other requirements are satisfied.
- 48. <u>Category discrepancies</u>. For candidates who wrongly declared the category and if same is noticed at a later stage during Physical Verification then the category tag of the candidate will be changed (for the purpose of seat allocation) to General and Candidate will be considered for seat allocation in subsequent round(s) for the remaining seats for seat allocation (if any), provided all other requirements are satisfied.
- 49. Principal of schools will highlight all three types of situations mentioned in Para 46 to 48 to the Sainik Schools Society for consideration and further decision. The decision by the SSS with regard to such discrepancies shall be final.
- 50. Delays or disruptions in service due to the breakdown of AISSAC computer servers shall be rectified as early as possible and notified on the web portal. The decisions of AISSAC/SSS in this regard shall be final and binding.
